Following Rates and T&Cs valid till 31st December 2025 are applicable for Saudi Arabia Ports – Jeddah, Dammam, King Abdullah & Jubail only

- Above rates are only "service charges" for customs clearance and are applicable for up to 10 line items per Bayan. Above this, SAR 20 per additional line item per Bayan will be applicable
- For hazardous cargo, additional charge of SAR 120 per container will be applicable
- For Maersk Visibility IT solution, SAR56 per container will be applicable.
- Any other service or condition applicable for a shipment will be charged additionally and will be notified (some charges can be non-receipted) before initiating the clearance or during the clearance as soon as it is notified to Maersk
- Receipted charges will be charged at actuals with submission of receipts.
- Maersk will not be responsible for payment of Customs duties/taxes, VAT, etc. which may be applicable as per prevailing Rules and Regulations of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, and/or container deposits to shipping lines, unless pre-agreed by Maersk in the contractual agreement
- DDP shipments may require additional documentation and approvals from Maersk, please send an email to <u>mostafa.aly@maersk.com</u> before accepting this quote
- Rate requests for other container types (Open Top OOG/Flat/Tank etc.) or for other Mode of Transport (eg: cross border) to be sent to mostafa.aly@maersk.com
- All requirements to be fulfilled and complied by Importer/Exporter as per Saudi Customs Rules & Regulations such as (Cargo registration, documentation, authorizations etc.) to enable the clearance request acceptance. - Commodities NOT in our scope of services a) Re-export b) Tobacco and related commodities/accessories c) Personal effects d) Cars. Please note that this is NOT an exhaustive list and it will be at the discretion of Maersk to inform at the earliest should we decide to not participate in the clearance of a commodity once the request is placed
