Operational Disruptions on European Rail Network

Dear Valued Customers,

We would like to provide an update on the current situation across the Northern European rail network.

While operations remain active, rail services continue to be affected by a combination of recent network disruptions, infrastructure constraints, and capacity limitations across parts of Central Europe. As a result, recovery across the network is progressing more slowly than anticipated.

The accumulated impact of these disruptions is continuing to affect train and equipment rotations, leading to congestion and reduced operational flexibility. We still experience longer transit times and occasional schedule adjustments on rail shipments moving between Central Europe and North European ports.

In addition, several planned infrastructure works across the network in the coming weeks are expected to place further pressure on available rail capacity and may contribute to ongoing service challenges.

Our teams remain in close contact with rail operators and terminal partners and are working actively to minimize the impact on your supply chains wherever possible.

We appreciate your patience and understanding as the network continues to stabilize and apologize for any inconvenience caused.
