Customer Advisory – Koper Omission MV SALAHUDDIN

Dear Customer,

We would like to inform you of a temporary disruption affecting the scheduled call of MV SALAHUDDIN at the Port of Koper. Due to ongoing civil works at the main berth, no vessels will be able to berth in Koper during the vessel's planned arrival window (week 28). To maintain overall schedule reliability and minimize broader network disruption on the AE12 service, Koper call has regrettably been omitted. To reduce the impact on your shipments, the following contingency measures have been implemented:

Exports

- All export cargo originally planned for MV SALAHUDDIN has been rerouted via MV Brussels Express

Imports

- All import cargo will be discharged at Port Said (Egypt) and subsequently repositioned to Koper via dedicated shuttle vessels:
 - NYSTED Maersk
 - Maersk NAKURU

These shuttle vessels will berth at the feeder terminal in Koper as soon as berthing space becomes available. Detailed schedules will be shared at a later stage once finalized. We understand that this disruption may cause inconvenience and appreciate your understanding as we take these measures to ensure continuity and stability of our service.
