Inspection Fee - Scanning Export/Import in Germany

Dear Valued Customer,

Inspection Fee - Scanning Export/Import in Germany refers to a service provided if customs or other authorities request a container to be scanned or doors to be opened for a visual check. German Customs Authorities submit their request directly to the Terminal operator, who will arrange the transfer of the container to the new scanning area accordingly and process the query.

Please note, we will not be able to provide you with any official written confirmation of scan examination. You can find the current Inspection Fee - Scanning related charges on the Maersk Germany Information page:

This procedure might apply to all containers arriving, discharging, or transshipping at the port of Bremerhaven. Container selection for scanning is solely done by customs authorities, and up to their decision out of Maersk control.
