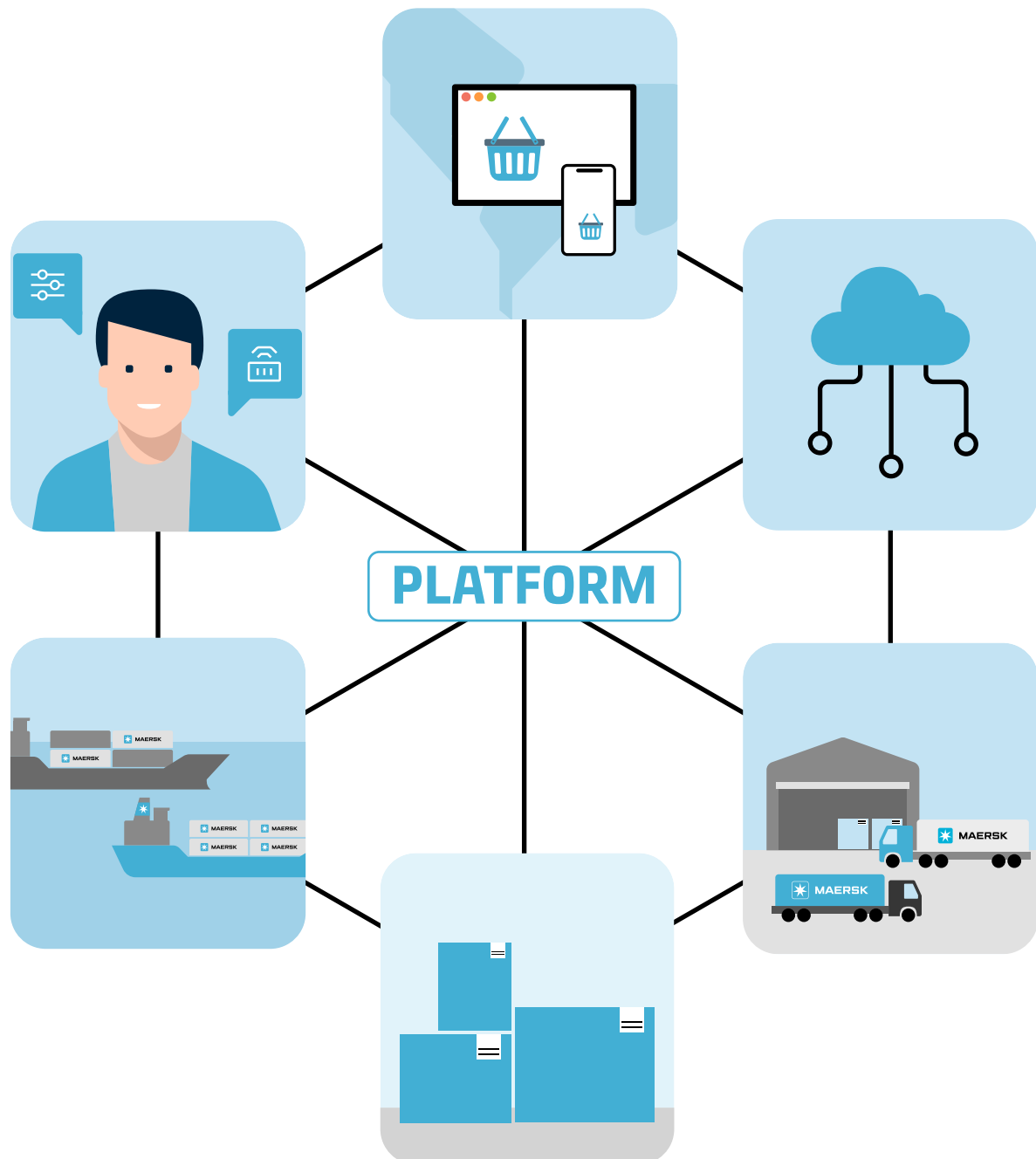


Decarbonisation is influencing customer choices

Expert Interview – Voices from Maersk

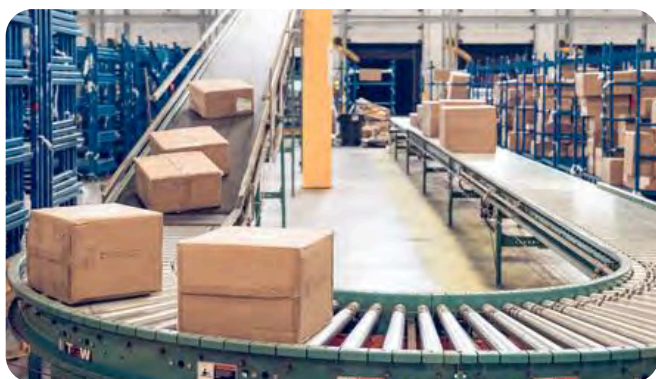

How is technology changing the role of warehouses in supply chains?

Warehouses are no longer static storage spaces; they are becoming intelligent command centres. With AI and automation, we can design smarter layouts, use robotics to increase throughput, and deploy predictive maintenance to avoid disruptions. This allows us to build larger and more efficient distribution centres that handle higher volumes with speed and accuracy.



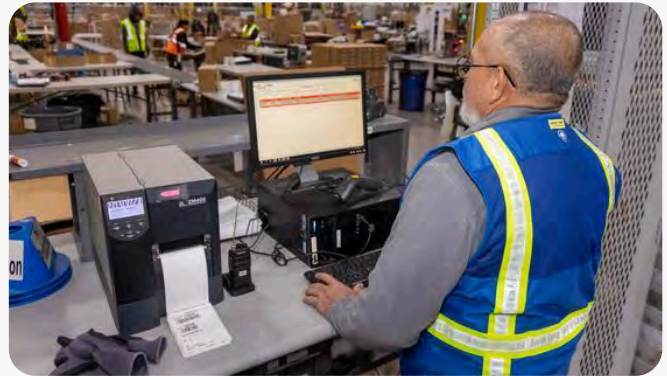
You've mentioned the idea of a "zero-touch" future. What does that mean for warehousing?



It's about moving toward a model where up to 80% of logistics tasks can be automated in the next few years. In practice, AI will manage SKUs in real time, adjust operations for seasonal peaks, and orchestrate flows with minimal manual intervention. People will focus more on oversight, innovation, and exceptions, while repetitive tasks become automated.

What are the most impactful innovations you see today?

Predictive routing is one — it reduces transit time variability and improves fuel efficiency. Inventory forecasting is another key aspect, ensuring products are available at the right place and time. And digital twins are a game-changer: we can simulate operations, optimise layouts, and test scenarios virtually before investing in physical changes. These tools make supply chains more resilient and responsive.



What challenges do businesses face in adopting these models?



The main challenges are integration and change management. You need strong data governance, robust infrastructure, and systems that talk to each other. But equally important is preparing people to thrive in hybrid environments, where humans and machines collaborate. It's as much about culture and skills as it is about technology.

Looking forward, what excites you the most about this evolution?

The opportunity to offer customers supply chains that are predictive, resilient, and designed around their needs. With smarter, more flexible, and more transparent operations, companies can respond to market shifts faster, reduce costs, and improve sustainability. That's the future we're building.
