

## Freight shipping cost calculation checklist

1	Cargo preparation
	Clearly define cargo type (standard, hazardous, refrigerated).
	Accurately measure cargo weight and dimensions.
	Select correct shipment mode (air, ocean, road, rail).
2	Cost considerations
	Request freight quotes, including fuel surcharges, THC, and handling fees.
	Consider special handling requirements or accessorial fees.
	Clarify insurance coverage and premium.
3	Documentation and compliance
	Prepare relevant paperwork (commercial invoice, packing list, certificate of origin).
	Confirm Incoterms' clearly.
	Complete all necessary customs documents (HS codes, duties, tariffs).
4	Planning and scheduling
	Confirm realistic transit times with your logistics service provider.
	Build contingency budgets for unexpected costs or delays (demurrage, detention).
	Schedule shipments strategically, considering peak-season impacts on costs.
